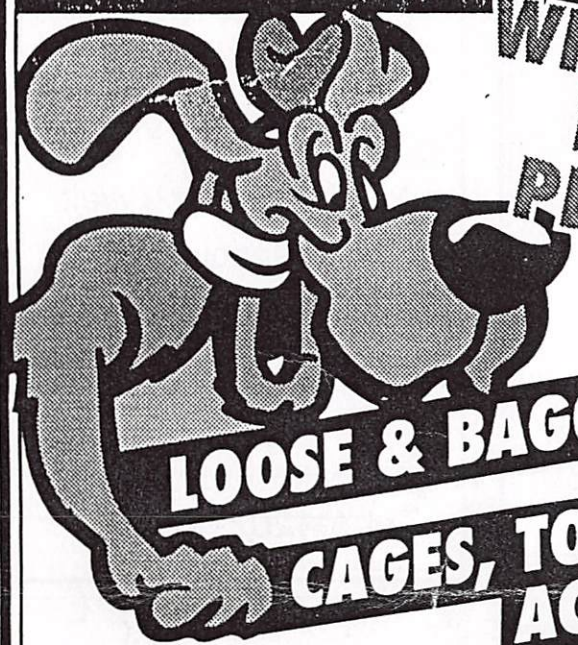

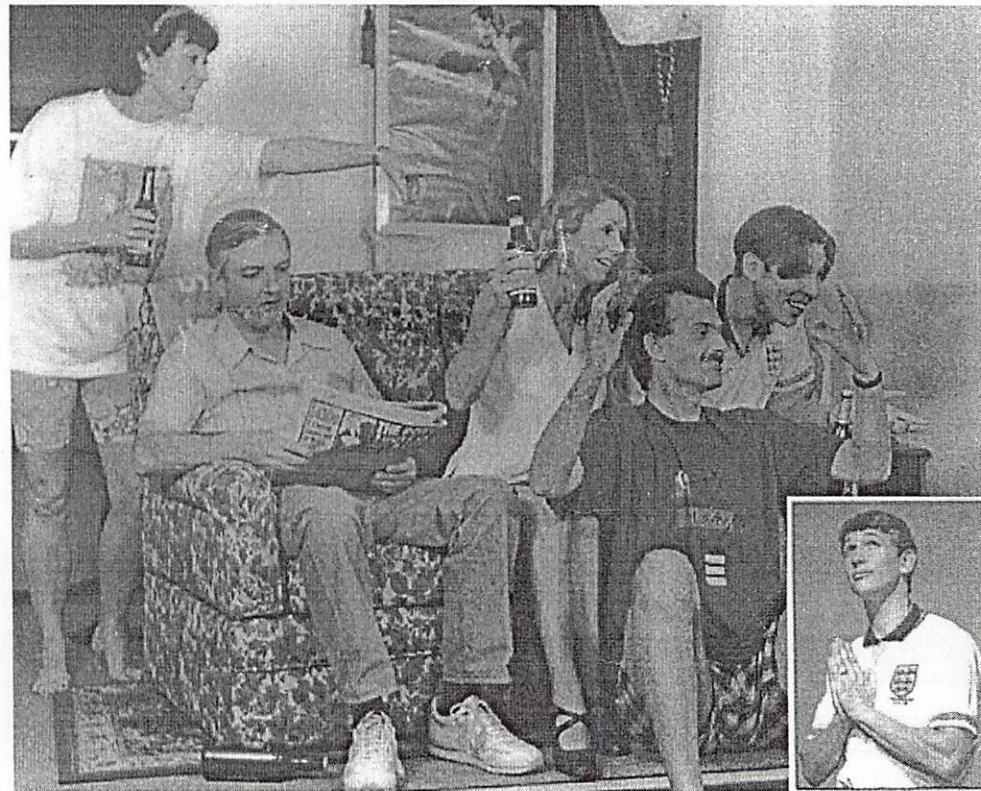

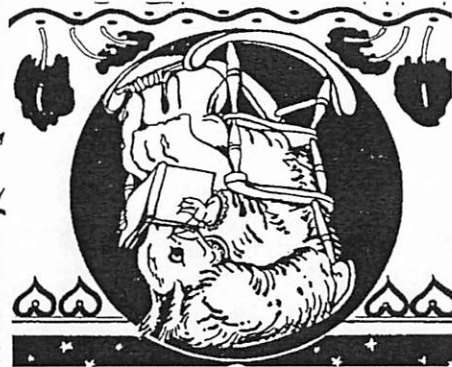

10 Things You Didn't Know about Gary Lineker

1. Gary Winston Lineker was born at St Francis maternity hospital, Leicester, at 7am on 30th November 1960, Sir Winston Churchill's 86th birthday.

2. Gary started off as a £16-a-week apprentice with Leicester City in 1976.

3. When he made his Football League debut for Leicester City against Oldham on 1st January 1979, Gary was just 5ft 7in and nine-and-a-half stones.

4. At 16 Gary was torn between football and cricket and seriously considered a professional career with Leicestershire.

5. His schoolboy hero was former England and Leicester striker Frank Worthington.

6. When he was a teenager — and if

he wasn't playing football — Gary used to work on his dad's fruit & veg market stall for £4 a day.

7. Gary's kid brother Wayne was once considered the better footballer, but he didn't have Gary's attitude and temperament.

8. Gary and wife Michelle were married on 4th July 1986.

9. Gary's pet hates are smoking and Indian food.

10. Gary left City of Leicester Boys' school at 16. His headmaster wrote in one report: "Gary should spend more time studying because he will never make a living playing football."

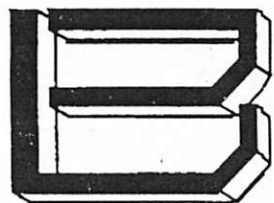
