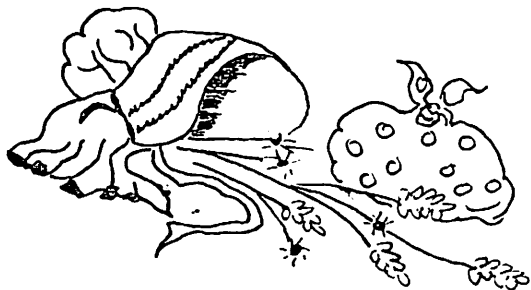

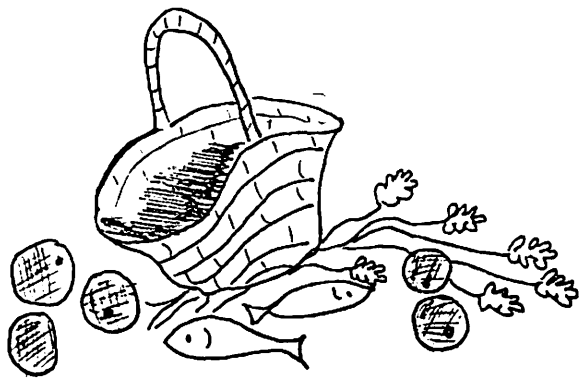
Finally, a thank you has, of course, to go to you for supporting us this evening and I hope that you will enjoy this production.

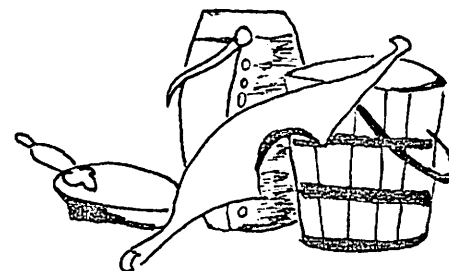
