Director's Notes

Some might ask why Agatha Christie? Why attempt a play set in the 1950s with completely different social values and mores to that of the modern generation?

Well to me it is precisely because of this perceived more gentle time. Because it allows us escape to a world which, although it probably never truly existed in reality, gives us a chance to relax and enjoy a mystery. And this play, with its many twists and turns, is a true example of Agatha Christie's power to surprise.

The demands of putting on this play are somewhat challenging, with a large cast and the fairly daunting problem of either building a full scale replica courtroom, with all its attendant costs, or of having a completely minimalist set and relying on the audience's imagination to a great degree. Hopefully I have struck a balance between the two, and shortly you will be able to iudge for vourself.

The play was adapted by Christie from her own short story. She was persuaded, somewhat against her will, to make it into a courtroom drama, and transformed it in less than three weeks into the play you see today. It opened in October 1953 and Christie said it was, "The one night at the theatre that will always stand out in my memory."

It ran for 468 performances in London, crossed to the US and played for 645 performances on Broadway, where it won an award for best foreign play. In 1957 it was given the Hollywood treatment in Billy Wilder's unforgettable film.

In our production I have a marvellous cast who have worked very hard to make this an enjoyable evening for you all. I hope their work will be crowned with success, and that you will enjoy watching as much as I have enjoyed directing.
